Things have certainly been busy around the church lately! This past week we were able to get the playground sinkhole repaired and, we also had the downstairs floors stripped and waxed.

We are so grateful to Tom and Marian Brinley and their company, Brinley's Grading Service, for taking care of the sinkhole repairs. Their sons, Robby and Chad, supervised the work, and we greatly appreciate all the time and effort that they have generously given to make our playground useable once again. In the coming weeks the fence will be replaced, new pine straw will be put down and everything will be back to normal again.

Also, we had the basement floors stripped and waxed last weekend. This is a time consuming and fairly expensive process so we are asking everyone to work together to keep the floors in our fellowship rooms, the kitchen and the hallways protected from skid marks and scratches. When moving chairs, tables and other furniture, pick them up and move them from place to place as needed, do not push or drag them across the floors, as this will scratch the new wax.

Much of these improvements were paid from our church budget, so please continue to offer your tithes and offerings to the church budget.
