Have you noticed? There is a tremendous battle going on in our world today. It is a battle between right and wrong, good and evil, justice and injustice, truth and falsehood, morality and immorality, decency and indecency, civility and incivility, etc. and we are right in the middle of it.

James Russell Lowell called it "The Present Crisis". The crisis of his time was slavery. He spoke of "Truth forever on the scaffold, wrong forever on the throne." And, it does seem that way, doesn't it. Ever since Adam and Eve rebelled against God, disobeyed his instructions and took the forbidden fruit every generation has had a present crisis.
