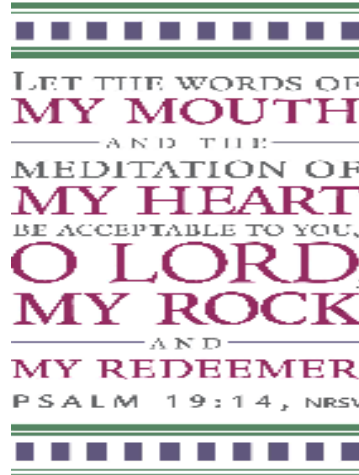

What do you do when you wake up in the morning? Do you think about what you have to do for the next 16 hours? Go to school...to work...to church...to visit or help someone, finish a project you've started, repair something, clean the house, write a letter, go to a meeting, etc. The list goes on forever, it seems. Eventually, the day is gone, you're tired, and it's bedtime. Then, maybe you quickly read a verse of scripture, say a brief prayer, and fall asleep.

If that's what we do, we have missed the most important thing of all. We haven't spent quality time with the Lord. Actually, that should be our priority for the day. That special time with Him will affect everything we do. A brief meditation or prayer is fine any time during the day. However, if we are to grow in our relationship with the Lord, we need to spend time reading His Word, and thinking about what He's teaching us, or what we can learn from it, and how it might apply to our lives. Then we need to spend time in prayer talking to God. There's an acronym I use for that time of prayer that I learned from a Bible study...**A C T S**.

A: Adoration = Praise...praising Him

C: Confession...confessing our sins of commission and omission

T: Thanksgiving...thanking Him for our many blessings

S: Supplication...praying for our families, friends, church, nation, etc

Morning is good, but any time you spend with the Lord is good. If an hour sounds like too much, start with 30 minutes, dividing the time between reading the Bible and prayer. Maybe you'd like to commit to it for 30 days. You'll find that it will make a difference in your life and you'll still be able to accomplish that list of things you needed to do.
