I remember all the laughter, tears, accomplishments, hugs and kisses.

I don't remember the bone-numbing fatigue and the pain of having to watch your little one endure the pain of a shot or the frustration of a cold. Not as vividly, anyway.

My daughter, Jenny, is going through that sense of realization that soon she will have two little souls relying on her for virtually everything. She is currently visiting with a friend who is dealing with an almost 3 year old and an 8 week old. Just talking on the phone, Jenny is aware of the new parent struggles her friend is having. I advised her before she left to be wary of letting her friend's experience get the best of her. The thing that Jenny has going for her is family. She has several family members who live here in Raleigh who can rescue her on the days she really feels overwhelmed. Her friend, however, lives with her husband in Florida. There are no family members close enough to help out with these difficult weeks. Steve and I have always lived in NC while our families are in VA. My children's grandparents would happily take them for a few days but there was no one here to step in and help when I was desperate for a few hours of uninterrupted sleep. But we managed. And the kids grew up. So fast.

One thing that Christians have that others don't is that extra help from Heaven. No, God is not going to send down an angel to watch the toddler while mom and baby nap. He might lead in a particular direction as you are desperately trying to decide if your child needs to go to the doctor or not. God is available 24/7. He is "on call" to support you as you make decisions and care for your children. As we get older, the roles switch and those of us with adult children find ourselves caring for our own parents. He's available to us for that responsibility as well. He always has been. He always will be. It's a wonderful life!!
