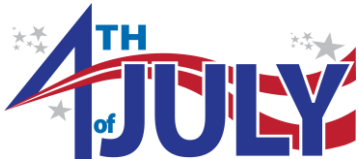

THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

A woman who just happened to be a Sunday School teacher had an affair which rocked the church and community. When confronted by church leaders and told that she could no longer teach her Sunday School Class, she made the statement, "What I do with my body has nothing to do with my spiritual life". Nothing could be further from the truth.

Paul said in 1 Thessalonians 5:23 "May your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. In Galatians 5:16-17 Paul said, "...Walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do."
