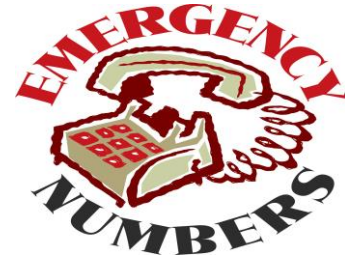


SHARE THE SONSHINE
