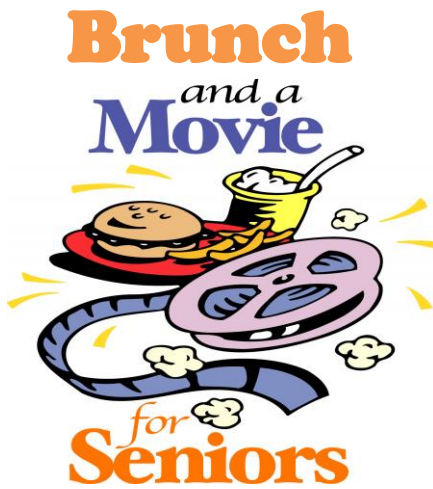

THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

Little Emily was having difficulty with the Lord's Prayer. She prayed, "Our father, who does art in heaven." How often do you look up at the sky to observe God's heavenly art? The Psalmist said, "The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge. They have no speech, they use no words; no sound is heard from them. Yet their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world (Psalm 19:1-4).

We cannot know the many days and nights that David, the shepherd boy, found strength, encouragement, comfort and inspiration from observing God's art work in the sky. The Psalms he wrote testify to the inspiration he received from looking up into the heavens. There are unspoken messages in the heavens every day if we will just take time to look and meditate. One day I looked up and saw a large cross in the sky reminding me of the victory we have in Jesus death and resurrection.
